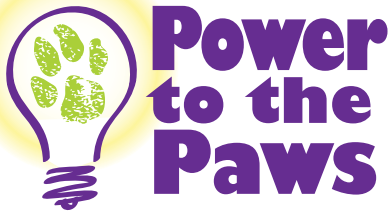

Power to the Paws – Generator Application Form – Part 2

In order to provide as many groups as possible with generators, we ask you to think realistically about your potential needs and request a generator that will be sufficient to meet them, and not choose a larger one “just in case.” Larger generators are more expensive and we won’t be able to purchase as many as we will smaller ones.

We’ve included a list of appliances you might have at your shelter as well as the necessary wattage for each item. Please look at the list, consider what items you will need to run and when you will need to run them (for example, you may need to run both a microwave and a coffee maker, but do you have to run them at the same time?), check off each item, and total the amount of wattage you will need. We can then choose an appropriate generator to meet your needs.
